Location: Situated on the coast of Northern New England at a former SAC base, Port City Air and Pease International Airport are strategically located and operationally prepared for trans-continental and trans-Atlantic missions regardless of scope, size or complexity.

Infrastructure: As a joint use military installation and civilian airfield, Portsmouth International (KPSM) is an ARFF Index E, Port of Entry airport able to launch and receive aircraft of any size. Operations are conducted 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

Scope of Service: As the DLA contract fuel provider at KPSM, Port City Air dispenses contract fuel with or without FSII, stored in our 350,000-gallon fuel farm and rolling fleet of trucks. Non-contracted JP-8 fuel is also readily available.
